If a leak is detected, a water shut-off system can automatically turn off your water supply and notify you before serious damage occurs.

ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY PLAN

HIRE A TRUSTED HOUSE

A caretaker should check on your home at least once a day during mild weather and two times a day during colder months. Always perform a background check.

An energy audit can identify hidden issues that could put plumbing at risk, including insulation gaps, air leakage, duct leakage, and moisture issues.

INSTALL SMART-HOME TECHNOLOGY

Depending on the system you select, you can control the thermostat, security and video systems, lights, appliances, and more from anywhere on your smartphone, tablet, or computer.
